MS in VLSI and Embedded System

JNTU, Hyderabad in association with Seer Akademi started a MS programme in VLSI and Embedded System in accordance with the memorandum of understanding signed between them. The programme was officially launched recently by the JNTUH Vice Chancellor, D.N. Reddy.

The JNTU has selected the first batch of 54 students for the programme through an interview process. While JNTU provides classrooms to run this programme at their campus, the Seer Akademi will deliver the course material. The course will be delivered in a combination of web and class-

room teaching coupled with industrial exposure.

The top student of the programme will be awarded with a cash prize which will be equal to the fee paid by the student for the course.

This will be on an annual basis. This amount will be adjusted during the next year.

The meritorious students will be eligible for special training in the specialised labs of Seer Akademi in USA, Armenia, Taiwan or in Bangalore.

The Akademi will promote all good and eligible ideas from students and also help in incubation and product development.
